- Projected pool opening: Friday, May 24
- Coordinate large sled dumpsters for large-item removal (mattresses, refuse from remodeling, furniture (dismantled), etc).
- Pool closing: Tuesday, Sept. 3
- Monthly board meetings, with a representative of Welch Randall available, will continue on Zoom
- Spring, summer, and fall community walk-throughs will continue with Brad and available Board members. Specific contractors will be included when a particular issue needs professional input.

Votes taken by Board

- During the March walk-thru, the Board identified 8 units with failing window tape. A previous board voted to not replace failing window tape with HOA funds. The current Board voted to continue this path and require homeowners with failing tape to repair and/or replace windows with their own funds. Brad will message individual owners needing to repair window tape. Below are some contacts for window repair and/or new windows:
 - Day & Night Glass, 801-515-6948. Historically used to fix window tape
 - Window World, 801-685-3480. Utilized for the HOA stackable windows. Refer others from our community for a discount.
 - Advanced Window Products, 801-505-9622. Refer others from our community for a discount.

Please remember you must receive board approval prior to purchase/replace windows to ensure exteriors match in the community.

- The monthly HOA feel increased to \$325/month, effective March 1, 2024. This increase is necessary to refill our liquid assets after some expensive projects in the last couple of years, to replenish and maintain our reserve fund at the required level, and to sufficiently prepare for large maintenance and infrastructure projects coming up in the near future. Also, our insurance premium rose significantly.
- The Board voted to move our Reserve account funds to a high-yield savings account with Capital One to help increase funds for capital projects.

- ** In accordance with the CC&Rs, the Board and Welch Randall are reviewing the current parking assignments. About 24 homeowners still have not completed the parking survey. Welch Randall will contact those owners to clarify parking for garages and carports.
- ** The Board conducted an RV lot audit in April and found unauthorized vehicles being stored. The owners of those unauthorized vehicles have until May 3 to claim their vehicle(s) and either pay the Countryside storage fee or move them off the property. Storage fees are \$30/month for a small spot, and \$50/month for a large spot. Unauthorized/unpaid vehicles will be tagged with a 2-week warning, then towed if not claimed/paid. The Board will audit the RV lot monthly.
- ** Landscaping weekly lawn maintenance started in April. Friday is our regular maintenance & mowing day (depending on weather).
- ** Bids are still being sought for outdoor railing repairs, a fence repair near the front of the community, painting, and pool repair by CPO (our current pool maintenance provider). We received painting bids from D&P Professional Painting, Certa Pro, and Apex Contracting. The Board received color samples from Apex and locations of 4 local Apex projects completed in the last 5 years to verify references. We contacted offices familiar with these projects to learn if they were completed on time, on budget, verify safety of the projects, if these contacts would recommend Countryside's use of Apex for our painting and siding work, and any other lessons learned during their projects. Members of the Board will visit these properties to view the quality of the work. The Board is also seeking bids to grind concrete at our dumpster enclosures per recommendations from vendors.
