CONDITIONS COVERING THE USE OF THE SWIMMING POOL

I. GENERAL

- -Pool will be available to members of the Meadows East each day during the season from 9:00 am to 9:00 pm.
- -The season for the swimming pool will be from Memorial Day through Labor Day, generally.
- -"Members" are resident owners or resident tenants, and/or immediate family of same <u>residing</u> at Meadows East, hereinafter referred to as Members.
- -Members are responsible for the safety and welfare of their own children and their invited guests.

II. SECURITY

- -The gate to the pool area has been equipped with a self-closing hinge apparatus and self-locking latch. Members desiring use of the pool may obtain a key from the office manager 801.479.4385, by receiving the pool rules, completing the Request For Use Of Meadows East Swimming Pool and returning it with a \$50.00 fee plus a \$10.00 key deposit. An adult member must fill out the request.
- -Misuse of the pool key or allowing non-members in, will result in having the lock changed and the cost of the same to be paid by the members using the pool. Your pool privileges could be taken away if you abuse your key usage.

III. MANAGEMENT

- -The Management Committee (Board of Directors) has complete authority to enforce all pool regulations.
- -Failure to abide by the rules will result in forfeiture of pool privileges for the entire season.
- -Uncensored misconduct of an invited guest will constitute grounds for removal of member's privileges.
- -Any questions regarding pool operation, rule changes, etc., should be made in writing to the Meadows East Board of Directors.
- -Your committee will make every effort to operate the pool in a way that will be to everyone's pleasure, comfort, and safety. Do your part by being considerate and thoughtful of others using the pool. By observing the rules, we can avoid unpleasantness.

IV. GUEST POLICY

- -Members are fully responsible for the conduct of both their family members and invited guests. They will also be responsible for advising them of the rules of conduct and safety.
- -Guests are defined as "persons not actually in residence at the Meadows East"
- -Guests may be limited to a maximum of three (3) except, for immediate family guests: there is no limitation,
- -For a guest to qualify to use the pool, the member must accompany the guest at all times while in the pool area, with the exception of house guests: house guests may use the pool without the owner present, as long as they are accompanied by an adult (no children under 14 may be at the pool without adult supervision) subject to their obeying the rules.

- -All guests must use their sponsor's residence for showering and changing before entering the pool area.
- -Shoes must be worn to the pool area.

V. CONDUCT, HEALTH, AND SAFETY

- -Before entering pool, a "cleansing shower" must be taken. "Cleansing shower" means the cleaning of body surfaces with soap and water to remove any matter that may wash off into the pool while swimming including fecal matter, lotion, hair products, makeup and deodorant.
- -Children under age 14 must be accompanied by and adult, age 18 or older at all times, NO EXCEPTIONS.
- -Children under 14, not accompanied by an adult will be asked to leave the pool area.
- -No oil base skin or suntan lotion will be used. Persons using oil base lotions will not be allowed to enter the pool. Use only silicone base lotions if you plan on entering.
- -Children wearing diapers or naked babies will not be permitted in pool.
- -Any child three years old and younger, any child not potty trained, or anyone who lacks control of defecation shall wear a water resistant swim diaper and a waterproof swimwear. Swim diapers and waterproof swimwear shall have waist and leg openings fitted such that they are in contact with the waist or leg around the entire circumference.
- -Diapers may not be changed poolside. Diapers must be changed at owner's residence and the child and person who change the diaper must wash their hands and take a cleansing shower after the diaper change.
- -A person who has or has had diarrhea within the last two weeks may not enter the pool.
- -If a fecal accident occurs in the pool, management must be notified immediately.
- -"Horseplay" is forbidden: for your own safety, please no rough or boisterous play and no running around the pool.
- Only acceptable swimsuits will be permitted in the pool; absolutely no cut-offs, Levis, shorts, etc. will be allowed.
- -No dogs or other animals are permitted in the pool area.
- -No contaminants will be placed in the pool: no object shall be allowed to enter the pool which does not belong such as rocks, lawn chairs, fence post caps, golf balls, etc.
- -NO GLASS CONTAINERS allowed in the pool area, use non-breakable containers.
- -In case of summer lightening storms, swimmers must leave pool immediately.
- -No food allowed in pool area.
- -Use trash receptacle for disposing of beverage cans, cigarettes, and other waste materials.
- -No one is allowed in pool that has a fever, a communicable disease, skin infection, sore or inflamed eyes, cough, cold, or is wearing a bandage or adhesive tape.
